“RCR”

To qualify for Ashlar-Vellum’s Research/Charitable/Retired special-use license, you must provide proof that you are one of the following:

- A non-profit research institution engaged exclusively in civilian research
- A non-profit academic or charitable organization
- A non-profit arts organization (such as a museum, opera company or live-performance theater)
- A fully retired individual over 65 years old, doing non-commercial design work only, and are not engaged in active or gainful employment of any kind.

Please read carefully and sign to the terms and conditions of the agreement allowing Ashlar-Vellum to issue you your permanent registration code.

By purchasing under the terms of the special-use software, you agree:

- To use this license for academic civilian research purposes only, or in the business of an academic or charitable institution (such as facilities management), or as a fully retired individual doing design work for yourself or a non-profit organization for no remuneration.
- To NOT use this license for research purposes on military projects (commercial license required).
- To NOT use this license commercially in any for-profit venture, nor to use any of the files created with this license for any commercial purposes.
- To provide proof of 501(c)3 status with the Internal Revenue Service (or equivalent) upon request.
- That any transfer of this license is subject to these special-use restrictions.
